**Mazzaro watch:** Former River Cats right-hander Vince Mazzaro had his major league scoreless streak snapped Friday night in a pitchers' duel against San Francisco ace Tim Lincecum. Ironically, it was Lincecum who recorded the first RBI off Mazzaro since the A's prospect joined the big club earlier this month. Lincecum singled to center to score the first of three runs in the fifth inning off Mazzaro. It was the only three runs the Oakland right-hander allowed in 6.0 innings of work. He struck out four batters, walked one and allowed six hits. Mazzaro had a no-hitter through 4.0 innings. Mazzaro's scoreless streak to open his major league career ended at 17.2 innings, spanning his first two starts and 4.0 innings Friday. Last Sunday, the right-hander pitched 7.1 innings of shutout ball against Baltimore, increasing his scoreless streak to 13.2 innings to start his major league career. After two consecutive Pacific Coast League Pitcher of the Week performances while with the River Cats, the A's called up Mazzaro to the big leagues June 2. The 22-year-old right-hander responded with a dazzling performance that night, throwing 6.1 innings of shutout ball to earn his first career major league victory. Mazzaro had allowed just one earned run over his last 28.2 innings of work with Sacramento, dating back to a May 6 outing against the Reno Aces. Including his time with Sacramento, Mazzaro has allowed only one run over the past 46.1 innings of work. He has a 2-0 record in Oakland. Mazzaro is next scheduled to pitch Friday night in San Francisco, when he will face Giants ace Tim Lincecum (5-1, 2.96).

**Close call:** Sacramento pulled off another one-run victory Friday night against Tacoma, scoring a run off of an error in the sixth inning to grab a 3-2 lead. The River Cats are now 12-5 in one-run games and 11-2 at home in one-run games. Sacramento is also 9-3 in extra-inning games, 5-1 at home. Both teams traded two-run home runs early Friday night, with Gregorio Petit hitting one for Sacramento in the third and Mike Morse hitting one for Tacoma in the fourth. In the sixth, Travis Buck, who singled to open the inning, scored from second when pitcher Ryan Rowland-Smith threw the ball into right field after fielding a bunt. Much of Sacramento's success in close games can be attributed to their bullpen, which has a 3.90 ERA on the season. On Friday, three different relievers combined to throw 3.0 scoreless innings. Ryan Webb, who leads the team with seven wins, earned his first save of the season by pitching 1.1 innings of hitless ball. Left-hander Jay Marshall leads all team relievers with a 2.08 ERA.

**Lefty has it right:** Gio Gonzalez, tonight's starting pitcher against the Tacoma Rainiers, struck out a season-high nine batters in his last start, Monday at home against Colorado Springs. As a team on that night, River cats pitchers gunned down a season-high 16 batters. Gonzalez, who threw 6.0 innings, did not allow any earned runs and allowed only one hit in 22 batters. Gonzalez has allowed one run in his last three outings, spanning 19.0 innings. He has dropped his ERA in the last three starts from 4.70 to 3.08. Gonzalez has three career starts against Tacoma, including one earlier this season, but has yet to record a victory against the Rainiers.

**Familiar face:** Former River Cats outfielder Travis Buck played his fourth rehab game for the Cats on June 12. He went 1 for 3 at the plate with a run and a walk. He now has a hit in each of his four games with the Triple-A club. The outfielder was instrumental to the River Cats' PCL and Triple-A championship run last season. In eight playoff games with the River Cats, Buck hit .313 (10 for 32) with a home run and four RBI. The 25-year-old played a total of 45 games with the River Cats. In his time with the team, he hit .296 with two home runs and 17 RBIs during the regular season. The Arizona native was drafted by the Oakland A's between the first and second round of the 2005 draft. After serving two years in the minors, Buck made his major league debut in 2007, playing in 82 games with Oakland.

**Valley clash:** The River Cats have yet to face the Fresno Grizzlies this season, which could make for a heated second-half title race. The teams will play each other 16 times over the next three months, with each team hosting eight games. The Grizzlies (the San Francisco Giants' affiliate) are doing their best to keep pace, winning seven of their last 10 games. The teams first meet from June 15-17 in Fresno, and the first series at Raley Field is July 1-3.

# TONIGHT'S STARTING PITCHER

## LHP Gio Gonzalez (2-1, 3.08)

Gonzalez has allowed one run in his last three outings, spanning 19.0 innings ... has dropped his ERA in the last three starts from 4.70 to 3.08 ... had a season-high nine strikeouts in 6.0 innings of work during his last start against the Colorado Springs Sky Sox on June 8 ... Gonzalez had his second consecutive solid outing on June 3 against Salt Lake City, allowing only two hits over 6.0 innings. He struck out five and walked two in the outing, earning the victory ... Gonzalez threw a masterful performance May 29 against Las Vegas, allowing only two hits in 7.0 innings. He struck out six and walked three but did not get a decision ... Against Omaha on May 24, Gio threw for 6.1 innings allowing four earned runs off of eight hits. The Royals managed to hit three home-runs off the lefty Gonzalez. Gonzalez struck out five batters and walked one, giving him a 4.70 ERA for the season. Gonzalez recorded his first loss of the season May 14, allowing eight runs (four earned) in 2.1 innings against visiting Albuquerque ... Gonzalez pitched for 5.0 innings against Las Vegas on May 9. He allowed three hits and four earned runs to score. Gonzalez also walked six and struck out seven batters while on the mound. ... In his outing vs Las Vegas on April 28th, he allowed two earned runs over 5.1 innings on April 28 in his last start with Sacramento, against Las Vegas ... pitched 4.2 scoreless innings April 23, but didn't get a decision against the host Portland Beavers. Struck out eight batters and walked only one in the outing ... Allowed two runs in 4.0 innings on April 18 against host Tacoma ... struck out four and walked two in the game ... pitched three hitless innings in his first start of the season against Portland on April 13 ... was taken out of the game after 38 pitches (19 strikes) ... Gonzalez made his Major League debut with Oakland in 2008 after compiling a 39-35 record and a 3.64 ERA (249 er in 615.1 ip) in 114 appearances, 111 starts, in five minor league seasons...had 705 strikeouts in 615.1 innings and held minor league opponents to a .223 (506 for 2266) batting average ... was named to the Pacific Coast League Postseason All-Star Team in 2008...was a Southern League Postseason All-Star in 2007 after leading all of minor league baseball with 185 strikeouts...tied 12th in the minors with 166 strikeouts in 2006 at Double-A Reading...participated in the 2006 All-Star Futures Game at PNC Park in Pittsburgh...has been traded three times in his career...was originally drafted by the Chicago White Sox as a compensation pick following the first round of the 2004 draft and was dealt to Philadelphia in the Jim Thome trade following the 2005 season...was reacquired by the White Sox following the 2006 season and was dealt to Oakland in the Nick Swisher trade in January, 2008.

**vs. Tacoma (0-1, 4.05):** Gonzalez has made three career starts against Tacoma ... in a June 13, 2008, outing against Tacoma (exactly one year to this date), Gonzalez allowed three earned runs over 6.1 innings, striking out eight and walking three ... In one start against the Rainiers during the 2009 season (April 18), Gonzalez earned a no-decision, pitching 4.0 innings and allowing one earned run off two hits, while striking out four.
