Let's get it started: River Cats starter Gio Gonzalez pitched an outstanding game Thursday night against Salt Lake. Gonzalez pitched for 5.1 innings, facing 23 batters and allowing only four hits and striking out 10, a season high. Of his 103 pitches, 66 were strikes. Gonzalez leads the River Cats in strikeouts (71), walks (34) and most strikeouts in a game (10). Gonzalez also has the lowest ERA (2.51) of all the River Cats starting pitchers.

Powerhouse June: The River Cats are currently 16 games into a 23-game stretch against teams with records better than .500. The stretch started with a four-game trip to Salt Lake (currently 38-30), in which the River Cats earned a four-game split. Sacramento then returned home for an eight-game homestand against Colorado Springs (38-29) and Tacoma (34-33), during which the River Cats won five of the eight games, including taking three of four from Tacoma. Sacramento then took off for Fresno (36-31), where they took two of three games from the Grizzlies earlier this week. The River Cats are now 10-6 during the 23-game stretch, and hold a six-game lead over Fresno. It doesn't get any easier for the Cats, as the team hosts Salt Lake and Colorado Springs over the next seven games.

Happy anniversary: The River Cats are celebrating their 10th season in Sacramento and have announced the results of the online fan voting for the 10th Season All-Time Team. Current River Cats who made the team are manager Tony DeFrancesco and relief pitcher Jeff Gray. Second baseman Mark Ellis, who is also on the All-Time Team, is currently playing for the River Cats on an MLB rehab assignment. Former River Cats include catcher Kurt Suzuki, first baseman Daric Barton, third baseman Eric Hinske, shortstop Bobby Crosby, outfielders Nick Swisher, Eric Byrnes and Hiram Bocachica, starting pitchers Barry Zito, Justin Duchscherer and Rich Harden and relief pitcher Brad Ziegler. Ten of these 14 players have won the PCL Championship with the River Cats while two are American League All-Stars (Duchscherer and Zito), two are American League Rookie of the Year Award winners (Crosby and Hinske) and one is an American League Cy Young Award winner (Zito). The first 3,000 fans at tonight's game will receive a free 10th All-Time Team poster and have the opportunity to receive autographs from DeFrancesco and Gray, who will be signing autographs on the concourse from 6:15-6:45.

Right off the bat! The River Cats collected a franchise-record eight home runs Wednesday night at Fresno. Eric Patterson stepped up to the plate to lead off the game with a home run to right field on a 2-2 pitch from the left-hander Steve Hammond. It seemed to be an early highlight that would not amount to much, as the Grizzlies scored three quick runs in the third inning to take the lead. However, the River Cats' long-ball exposition had just begun. Sacramento blasted three home runs in the fourth inning. Aaron Cunningham hit his first of two on the night with Travis Buck on first to tie the game. Two batters and one out later, Tommy Everidge would blast one out of Chukchansi Field and Anthony Recker would step up and hit another home run three pitches later. The River Cats had the lead, but were still hungry and had more home runs up their sleeve. After holding the Grizzlies scoreless in the fourth, the Cats would go on the offensive again. Matt Carson hit a two-run shot over the right-center field wall with Patterson on first base. While that was the only home run in the fifth inning, they would score seven runs (a season high) in the frame. In the sixth inning, Cunningham hit a second and identical two-run home run with Travis Buck on first base. Three batters and two outs later, Cliff Pennington hits his first home run of the season on new pitcher Osiris Matos' fifth pitch. Finally, in the seventh inning, second baseman Eric Patterson hit his second lead-off homer of the night over the right field wall on a 1-2 pitch. This brought the total to eight home runs for the night, accounting for 12 of their 19 runs. The eight homers in a game is a team record and two shy of the all-time Pacific Coast League record of 10, set by Phoenix Giants against the Sacramento Solons on June 22, 1974.

Best of the best: Sacramento has the best overall record in the PCL at 42-25, and leads the league in home victories with 24. The River Cats sit 17 games above .500 and are six games up on Fresno in the Pacific South Division. Sacramento also leads the Pacific Coast League in the highest attendance, averaging 8,917 fans per game with a grand total of 329,944. Fresno sits in second place in the PCL Pacific South Division, holding a 36-31 record on the season. Reno is 10.5 games out and Las Vegas trails Sacramento by 14.5 games.

TONIGHT'S STARTING PITCHER

RHP Chad Reineke (0-2, 4.89)

In his last start, Reineke pitched for 5.1 innings, facing 23 batters, allowing five hits, two runs, two earned runs, two walks and two strikeouts. Has struggled in his last three starts, allowing nine earned runs over 11.2 innings ... in his June 9 start against visiting Colorado Springs), Reineke allowed three runs over 4.0 innings. He gave up five hits, two walks and struck out two ... Pitched 2.1 innings on June 5 against Salt Lake City, allowing three hits and four earned runs. He also walked four batters and threw only 33 strikes ... had a dominant performance on May 31 against Las Vegas, allowing just two hits over 5.2 innings. He didn't allow a run, struck out five and walked two ... hasn't allowed a run over his last three appearances, spanning 11.1 innings ... in his last appearance (May 23rd), Reineke faced the Omaha Royals. He came in as a relief pitcher to throw for 1.0 innings allowing no hits or earned runs. He faced three batters ... Reineke has made five spot starts this season and come out of the bullpen eight times. ... In his four starts he has combined to throw 22.1 innings and allow eight runs ... He got a save against Portland on April 13, 2009, when he pitched 2.0 hitless innings with three strikeouts and one walk.

vs. Salt Lake (0-1, 9.39): Reineke has faced Salt Lake twice in his career, including once earlier this month ... He pitched 2.1 innings and faced 14 batters on June 5, allowing for three hits, four runs (all earned) and two strikeouts on June 5 ... In a 2008 start, he allowed six runs (four earned), three walks, three strikeouts and nine hits against Salt Lake.
