**Standout Cats:** Sacramento earned its first win of the this four-game series against Reno on Saturday night to bring the series to 2-1 in favor of the Aces. Right-handed pitcher Chad Reineke pitched for 7.0 innings and allowed only two runs to score in six hits. The two runs that did score came from solo home runs, one in the fourth and one in the sixth. Reineke earned his fourth win of the season and relief pitcher Jeff Grey earned his 12th save of the season. Also, on the offensive side of things, outfielder Travis Buck went 3 for 4 with an RBI, two doubles and a run. Eric Patterson went 2 for 4 and scored two runs off a double and a triple. Patterson now has the tenth best batting average in the league at .314. He also is in second with 111 hits, third with 69 runs, and second with 11 triples.

**Gray matters:** Sacramento relief pitcher Jeff Gray earned another save in Saturday's win over Reno. He has a team-best 1.87 ERA and team-high 12 saves. The right-hander has not allowed any runs in his last 6.0 innings pitched, spanning six appearances. In that span he has only allowed five hits. He has six strikeouts and only one walk in that span. For the season, the right-hander from Texas City, Texas, has allowed more than one run in an outing only once, and has never walked more than one batter in an appearance. For the season he has 18 strikeouts and six walks in 33.2 innings. He has allowed only two homers. Gray leads a bullpen that sports a 28-14 record and 3.52 ERA on the season.

**Tommy, we can hear you:** Sacramento slugger Tommy Everidge has been on a tear since being called up from Double-A Midland on June 9. In Saturday's game he had two RBIs, both from center field shots (one a sacrifice fly and the other a single). In 34 games with Sacramento, the first baseman has a team-high .338 batting average, seven home runs, 25 RBIs and 24 runs scored. On Friday night, Everidge smacked three hits, including two doubles. On Thursday night, he hit a monster home run that landed half way back on the batting cages to the left of the team's club house beyond the left-field wall. The Sonoma native has 11 doubles and a triple to his credit this season.

**It's heating up:** Sacramento flame-thrower Henry Rodriguez has used his 100 mph fastball to put up some astonishing strikeout statistics this season. For the season, he has struck out 45 batters in only 25.1 innings of work. That means Rodriguez has retired 59 percent of his batters by strikeout. Earlier in the month, the 22-year-old Zulia, Venezuela native recorded eight consecutive outs by strikeout. Rodriguez currently holds a 7.0-inning scoreless streak. On Friday night, he struck out two batters in 1.2 scoreless innings of work. Rodriguez, however, did throw a costly wild pitch in the eighth inning that allowed the go-ahead run to score. He then allowed a run-scoring double. Both runs were charged to left-hander Jay Marshall.

**Around the bend:** Saturday night's win over the Reno Aces was a welcome feeling for the River Cats. While Sacramento has fared well against South Division rivals Las Vegas and Fresno this season, they have struggled with their new neighbors up Highway 80. The Aces, in their first season since moving from Tucson, have beaten Sacramento seven of 11 times this season. Reno is 5-2 against Sacramento at Raley Field while the two teams have split four games in Reno. Sacramento pitchers hold a dismal 5.57 ERA against Reno this season, and the team has been outscored 68-57 in the 11 games. Sacramento holds a 8-3 record against Fresno this season with five games remaining against the Grizzlies at Raley Field in late August. Sacramento has completed its season series against Las Vegas, winning 10 of 16 games against the 51s. The River Cats hold a 9.0-game lead over Fresno in the division, with only today's game remaining between the two teams.

**Dinger's birthday:** Sunday is Dinger's 10th birthday, and the River Cats mascot is spending the day at Raley Field (his favorite park) with all of his mascot friends, including best friend Mr. Jelly Belly. Prior to the game, Dinger and friends are taking part in a mascot kickball game at noon.

# TODAY'S STARTING PITCHER

## RHP Shawn Chacon (2-2, 6.33)

In Chacon's last start (July 11) he faced the Fresno Grizzlies and recieved no decision. He Threw for 5.0 innings and allowed seven hits, three of them home runs, and six runs. He walked four batters, struck out three and hit one. ... Shawn Chacon struggled against the Reno Aces on July 6 as he gave up six earned runs on seven hits and struck out one batter in 3.0 innings pitched. It was Chacon's first time facing Reno in his Triple-A career. Two starts ago against Fresno on July 1, he allowed only two runs over 6.0 innings to earn the victory. He struck out four, walked three and threw a season-high 104 pitches ... In his first appearance with Sacramento this season against Salt Lake, Chacon pitched 6.0 innings, recording the win, facing 26 batters and allowing six hits, five runs, four earned runs, one walk and five strikeouts ... Chacon, who signed a Minor-League deal with the Athletics on June 18, was a starting pitcher for four different MLB teams including the Rockies, Yankees, Pirates, and Astros ... During the 2003 season with the Colorado Rockies, Chacon was a National League All-Star selection and finished 11-8 with a 4.60 ERA in 23 games on the year ... Chacon's most recent stint in the majors was in 2008 with the Houston Astros where he went 2-0 with a 3.95 ERA in his first 11 starts. He went on to drop three of the final four decisions for a final line of 2-3, 5.04 ERA in 15 starts ... Chacon's Major League career totals amount to 45-61 with a 4.99 ERA ... In 2009, Chacon was 3-3 with a 4.29 ERA with the Newark Bears, an Independant League team out of Newark, New Jersey ... Chacon's line with the Newark Bears shows: 42.0 IP, 41 H, 20 ER, 6 HR, 16 BB, 29 SO.

**vs. Reno (0-1, 18.00):** Chacon has faced the new Reno team only once in his long pitching career. In that appearance on July 6, he gave up six earned runs on seven hits and struck out one batter in 3.0 innings pitched. He recieved the loss for the outing. He will face them today at Raley Field where he will face their right hander, Hector Ambriz
