**Red-hot vs. RedHawks:** Brett Tomko, who will start tonight for Sacramento, has dominated Oklahoma City in three appearances through his career. He started against the RedHawks twice during the 2001 season, and no-hit them once and fired a complete game two-hitter in the other start. "It took a few innings to get comfortable out there and really kind of find my stuff," Tomko said to Sports Illustrated after his July 3, 2001, no-hitter. "Then about the fourth or fifth inning, I felt really good, kind of settled in. I was trying to throw the ball as hard as I could and I really didn't want to leave something too close to the plate." Tomko allowed one hit over 1.0 inning of relief against Oklahoma City on Wednesday. Overall, he has allowed three hits and no runs over 19.0 innings against Oklahoma City.

**Not over until it's over:** The River Cats were again successful in extra innings last night as they topped Oklahoma City 4-3 in 12 innings. Eric Patterson's steal of third base drew a wild throw from RedHawks catcher Emerson Frostad, which allowed Patterson to score the game-winning run easily in the bottom of the 12th. Sacramento moves to 6-1 at home in extra inning ball games this season, and has an 2009 extra innings record of 14-4 (.778). Last year the team played in only 12 extra-inning games, compiling a record of 5-7.

**Costly misfortune:** With a man on first and no outs in the top of the ninth inning of a 3-1 game Friday night, Greg Golson for Oklahoma City stepped up to the plate against Sacramento closer Jay Marshall. Golson hit a sharp ground ball to the second base side, where second baseman Eric Patterson was awaiting the grounder in hopes of turning the 4-6-3 double play to get the first two outs of the ninth inning. However, the ball ricochet off of the foot of umpire Bryan Rose and bounced into left field. Both runners were awarded their bases, and instead of two outs and nobody on base the River Cats faced runners on first and second with no outs. Two singles later, the RedHawks had tied the game at three. Marshall, who was hoping to earn his eighth save on the year, was given a blown save and the game headed to extra innings. Sacramento ended up pulling out the win in the 12th inning on a wild throw to third that allowed Eric Patterson to score. It was an eventful day for Patterson, who gave Sacramento the lead with a two-run homer in the second, but later failed to execute what could have been a game-winning suicide squeeze in the bottom of the ninth.

**What a relief:** Sacramento's bullpen has been a big part of the reason why the River Cats have prevailed in close games and in extra innings this season. They continued to show that intensity Friday night against Oklahoma City as Brad Kilby, Jay Marshall, Sam Demel, and Jerry Blevins all contributed from the Sacramento bullpen. The four of them combined to allow only two runs over 6.0 innings. The bullpen earned the victory in extra innings, the team's 14th extra-inning win on the season, and yet another one-run victory. Sacramento has a 21-11 record in one-run games, including a 15-3 mark at home. In extra-inning games, Sacramento is 14-4 on the season. The 18 extra-inning games is six more than the team played all last season, when they went 5-7. Sacramento's bullpen ERA is 3.63 with a 33-17 record. Left-hander Jay Marshall leads all active River Cats with seven saves, while Jeff Gray had 16 saves before being called up to Oakland. Left-hander Brad Kilby, a Laguna Creek High product who will be honored Saturday as part of Elk Grove Night Honoring Brad Kilby, leads all active River Cats with a 2.28 ERA on the season.

**Clutch performance:** Scott Hodsdon made his first career Triple-A appearance in a spot start Friday night for the River Cats against the Oklahoma City RedHawks. So far this season with the Stockton Ports, Hodsdon is 6-7 with a 5.40 ERA in 23 games, 17 of those being starts where he is 5-6. Last night, Hodsdon pitched 6.0 innings (the first five were scoreless), gave up five hits and allowed only one run. Hodsdon was unfortunately unable to pick up the win as the bullpen let his lead slip away. Hodsdon has been sent back to Stockton to continue work with the Ports.

**He's baaack:** In Friday night's ball game, Eric Patterson smashed his 10th home run of the season. That shot makes him only the second player in River Cats history to have at least 10 homers, triples, doubles and steals in a season. The only other player to accomplish that feat is Mark Bellhorn in 2000. In the month of July, Patterson batted .388 over 19 games before getting called up to Oakland. Sacramento is 57-32 when Patterson bats lead-off.

# TONIGHT'S STARTING PITCHER

## RHP Brett Tomko (1-0, 0.64 in International League)

Tomko was signed by the Oakland A's organization on August 5 as a free agent. The 36-year-old right-hander had spent the first half of the season in the New York Yankees organization, splitting time between Triple-A Scranton-Wilkes Barre and the New York Yankees ... In Scranton, Tomko allowed just one run over 14.0 innings between April 10 and May 7 for a 0.64 ERA. He struck out 17 and walked only four in that span ... In New York, from May 9 to July 10, Tomko allowed 12 runs over 20.2 innings for a 5.23 ERA. He struck out 11 and walked seven in that span ... Tomko began his pro baseball career in 1995 and made his major league debut with Cincinnati in 1997. He has a career major league record of 95-99 and a career MLB ERA of 4.68.
