**Patterson ties record:** In the last two games, infielder Eric Patterson has stolen three bases which rests him at a tie with Bo Porter for most stolen bases in a season in River Cats history. Porter set the bar of 39 steals back in the 2000 season. Patterson also smashed his 10th home run of the season in Friday night's game against Oklahoma City. That shot makes him only the second player in River Cats history to have at least 10 homers, triples, doubles and steals in a season. The only other player to accomplish that feat is Mark Bellhorn also in 2000. In the month of July, Patterson batted .388 over 19 games before getting called up to Oakland. Sacramento is 59-32 when Patterson bats lead-off. Patterson is batting .333 in four games with Sacramento this month, with a homer and two doubles.

**K-man:** Sacramento reliever Henry Rodriguez inherited a bases loaded with no out situation in the eighth inning of last night's game against New Orleans. He promptly turned around three straight batters by strikeout, and got the River Cats out of a jam that could have cost them the lead. Rodriguez earned the save, his third, and the River Cats improved to 16-3 at home in one-run ball games. Rodriguez has been nearly perfect in his four appearances so far in the month of August, allowing only two hits, zero earned runs, and striking out 10 in 5.0 innings. He is known to have a fastball approaching 100 mph, a pitch that has helped him earn a total of 58 strikeouts in 34.1 innings in 2009. That's an average of 1.7 strikeouts per inning, higher than any other pitcher on the team. The River Cats have escaped unscathed from four bases-loaded, no-out jams in the last two games.

**Did you say 'triple play'?:** Jerome Williams escaped a bases-loaded jam with an unconventional triple play (even by triple play standards) to help the Sacramento River Cats overcome their last major threat in an 11-4 victory over the Oklahoma City RedHawks on Saturday night. Williams had the bases juiced with no outs and the go-ahead run at the plate in Dustin Majewski in the sixth inning. Majewski hit a fly ball to left field that Chris Denorfia caught and fired home in an attempt to throw out Royce Huffman, who was tagging from third. Catcher Eric Munson caught the throw in front of home plate and fired to third base to throw out Casey Benjamin, who was attempting to advance from second. Shortstop Gregorio Petit tagged out Benjamin while his foot was on third base, which also forced out Huffman, who umpires determined had left third before Denorfia made the catch. Triple play.

**What a relief:** Sacramento's bullpen has been a big part of the reason why the River Cats have prevailed in close games and in extra-inning games this season. Shawn Chacon and Henry Rodriguez combined for 5.0 innings where they struck out eight to preserve a win in another one-run victory for Sacramento at home. Saturday night in the final game of the series against Oklahoma City, Jerome Williams and Mickey Storey combined to throw 7.1 scoreless innings to secure the victory. Williams escaped every inning unscathed despite allowing five hits and six walks. Storey, called up earlier in the day from Single-A Stockton, retired all five batters he faced to close the game. For the season, Sacramento's bullpen has an ERA of 3.57 and a record of 35-17, just one less win than the 2009 River Cats starters. The Sacramento pitching staff is ranked fourth in the Pacific Coast League, with an ERA of 4.14. Their 71 wins is eight more than any other team in the league, and they stand alone at the top with 821 strikeouts.

**Costly misfortune:** With a man on first and no outs in the top of the ninth inning of a 3-1 game Friday night, Greg Golson for Oklahoma City stepped up to the plate against Sacramento closer Jay Marshall. Golson hit a sharp ground ball to the second base side, where second baseman Eric Patterson was awaiting the grounder in hopes of turning the 4-6-3 double play to get the first two outs of the ninth inning. However, the ball ricochet off of the foot of umpire Bryan Rose and bounced into left field. Both runners were awarded their bases, and instead of two outs and nobody on base the River Cats faced runners on first and second with no outs. Two singles later, the RedHawks had tied the game at three. Marshall, who was hoping to earn his eighth save on the year, was given a blown save and the game headed to extra innings. Sacramento ended up pulling out the win in the 12th inning on a wild throw to third that allowed Eric Patterson to score. It was an eventful day for Patterson, who gave Sacramento the lead with a two-run homer in the second, but later failed to execute what could have been a game-winning suicide squeeze in the bottom of the ninth.

# TONIGHT'S STARTING PITCHER

## RHP Chad Reineke (5-4, 4.37)

Chad Reineke's last start was with the Oakland Athletics on August 5 against The Texas Rangers. In his first appearance with Oakland, he received a no-decision for his 5.0 innings of work where he allowed four earned runs off of seven hits. ... In his last Triple-A start (July 28) Reineke took a loss in a 6.2 inning effort where he gave up two earned runs. On July 23, Reineke faced the Tacoma Rainiers where he threw for 6.0 innings and earning his fifth win for the 2009 season. He allowed seven hits and five earned runs while striking out four batters of 27 faced. On July 18, against Reno, Reineke threw for 7.0 innings and allowed six hits and two earned runs ... On July 10 at Fresno, Reineke allowed three runs over 5.0 innings but did not get a decision. He struck out four, walked none and threw 90 pitches in the outing. ... Reineke has made 13 starts this season and come out of the bullpen eight times.

**vs. New Orleans (2-3, 3.67):** Reineke has made seven career appearances against the New Orleans Zephyrs, six of them starts. He has a 2-3 record against them, and has spread out 11 runs over 27.0 innings for his 3.67 ERA lifetime against the Zephyrs. In Reineke's six starts against New Orleans, he averaged 6.2 strikeouts per game.
