Race to the finish: Sacramento's magic number was reduced to 18 on Tuesday night with Fresno's loss to visiting Oklahoma City. The River Cats will face the Grizzlies (64-54) in what could be a critical five-game series in West Sacramento from August 26-30. Sacramento currently holds an 8-3 lead in the season series against Fresno.

In a pinch: In case of emergency, break out Matt Carson. That's been Tony DeFrancesco's motto this season in scenarios when he needs to save his bullpen. Carson, normally an outfielder, made his sixth pitching appearance this season in Tuesday night's 12-5 loss to New Orleans. The River Cats leader in home runs with 16 allowed one run in his only inning of work. Generally, it's not a good sign for Sacramento when Carson is on the hill, as Sacramento is now 0-6 in games in which he pitches.

Eyes on the record: River Cats MVP candidate Eric Patterson is just one stolen base shy of setting the team's single-season record of 40. He currently shares the record with Bo Porter, who also stole 39 stolen bases for Sacramento back in the 2000 season. Patterson's 39 steals places him third in the Pacific Coast League. Eric Young Jr. leads the league with 55 steals for Colorado Springs. Patterson's high month for stolen bases was back in May, when he swiped 11. He has five steals through only six games played so far in August. Sacramento has 26 games remaining in its schedule. However, if Patterson doesn't break the mark tonight, he would likely do it on an eight-game road trip to Nashville and Memphis.

In River Cats fashion: The 10-9 victory over the New Orleans Zephyrs on Monday was just another win for the River Cats, who have made a living from one-run victories this year. The Monday win brings the tally up to 23-11 with a 17-3 home record. Three of the team's last five games have been won by a one-run margin.

All 10s: Eric Patterson smashed his 10th home run of the season in Friday night's game against Oklahoma City. That shot makes him only the second player in River Cats history to have at least 10 homers, triples, doubles and steals in a season. The only other player to accomplish that feat is Mark Bellhorn also in 2000. Patterson hit his 11th homer in last night's game against New Orleans. In the month of July, Patterson batted .388 over 19 games before getting called up to Oakland. Sacramento is 59-32 when Patterson bats lead-off. Patterson is batting .346 in six games with Sacramento this month, with six runs, two home runs, nine RBIs and five stolen bases. He is fifth in the PCL is batting with a .328 batting average.

K-man: Sacramento reliever Henry Rodriguez inherited a bases-loaded, no-out situation in the eighth inning of Sunday night's game against New Orleans. He promptly struck out three consecutive New Orleans batters and got the River Cats out of a jam that could have cost them the lead. Rodriguez earned the save, his third. Rodriguez has been nearly perfect in his four appearances so far in the month of August, allowing only two hits, zero earned runs, and striking out 10 in 5.0 innings. With a fastball that can reach 100 mph, Rodriguez has total led 58 strikeouts in 34.1 innings in 2009. That's an average of 1.7 strikeouts per inning.

Did you say 'triple play'?: Jerome Williams escaped a bases-loaded jam with an unconventional triple play (even by triple play standards) to help the Sacramento River Cats overcome their last major threat in an 11-4 victory over the Oklahoma City RedHawks on Saturday night. Williams had the bases juiced with no outs and the go-ahead run at the plate in Dustin Majewski in the sixth inning. Majewski hit a fly ball to left field that Chris Denorfia caught and fired home in an attempt to throw out Royce Huffman, who was tagging from third. Catcher Eric Munson caught the throw in front of home plate and fired to third base to throw out Casey Benjamin, who was attempting to advance from second. Shortstop Gregorio Petit tagged out Benjamin while his foot was on third base, which also forced out Huffman, who umpires determined had left third before Denorfia made the catch. It was the first triple play in River Cats history.

TODAY'S STARTING PITCHER

RHP Brett Tomko (0-0, 13.50 in PCL)

In his last outing (August 8 against Oklahoma City), Tomko allowed four runs over 1.2 innings in his only start for Sacramento this season ... he pitched one scoreless innong of relief in his only appearance with Sacramento, also against Oklahoma City on August 5 ... was signed by the Oakland A's organization on August 5 as a free agent. The 36-year-old right-hander had spent the first half of the season in the New York Yankees organization, splitting time between Triple-A Scranton-Wilkes Barre and the New York Yankees ... In Scranton, Tomko allowed just one run over 14.0 innings between April 10 and May 7 for a 0.64 ERA. He struck out 17 and walked only four in that span ... In New York, from May 9 to July 10, Tomko allowed 12 runs over 20.2 innings for a 5.23 ERA. He struck out 11 and walked seven in that span ... Tomko began his pro baseball career in 1995 and made his major league debut with Cincinnati in 1997. He has a career major league record of 95-99 and a career MLB ERA of 4.68.

vs. New Orleans (0-1, 3.12): Tomko has faced New Orlenas three times in his minor league career, which has seen the veteran right-hander throw in the Pacific Coast lead during six different seasons (2000, 2001, 2004, 2006, 2008, 2009). He has faced the Zephyrs twice this season, both in relief appearances. In those outings (April 30 and May 3), he has combined to throw 2.2 shutout innings, allowing only one hit and striking out four while walking one. He earned the save in his May 3 outing against New Orleans. His only career start against New Orleans came during the 2001 season, when Tomko took the loss while allowing three runs over 6.0 innings of work.
