Great eight: The Sacramento River Cats' dynasty continued as they clinched another Pacific Coast League South Division title Thursday night, their eighth in 10 years. The River Cats are now in an elite club of American professional sports teams that have won eight division titles since 2000. Among the four major sports leagues and Triple-A baseball, only the New York Yankees (assuming they claim the American League East Division title this season) of Major League Baseball and the Detroit Red Wings of the National Hockey League have won eight titles this decade. "It's been a great season," said River Cats manager Tony DeFrancesco after clinching Thursday. "It's a great accomplishment for this team and these players to win another championship. No matter what happens in the postseason, nobody can take away what this team accomplished through a long grueling season. I look forward to seeing all the fans at Raley Field for the playoffs." Sacramento will now look to win its third consecutive PCL and Triple-A championships. "I am not going to cry," said River Cats MVP candidate Eric Patterson to his teammates in the clubhouse after Thursday night's game. "I want to thank all the guys, every single one of them for everything. We are the champs."

Carson City: Despite the two consecutive losses that Sacramento has suffered, Matt Carson has been unstoppable for the Cats. Carson collected one of the only three hits in last night's game, and on Friday night he hit a solo home run, his seventh in nine games. His past two performances with only one hit, came after a streak of seven consecutive multi-hit games. Over his last nine games, Carson has managed a .474 batting average with 13 runs, seven home runs and 12 RBIs. The center fielder leads the River Cats with 23 home runs and 71 RBIs on the season.

Welcome back, Tommy: Does everybody remember Tommy Everidge? The powerful first basemen was wrecking Triple-A pitchers back in July before being hoisted up to the big show in Oakland on July 28. In the month-and-a-half wearing a River Cats jersey, Everidge hit .375 with nine homers and 32 RBIs in 44 games played. He hit .359 with 14 runs and 14 RBIs in 20 games in June, and .400 with 17 runs and 18 RBIs in July.

Mortensen throwin' fire: Tonight's Sacramento starter, right-hander Clayton Mortensen, has 97 strikeouts in 2009. Excluding his most recent loss to Portland, Mortensen has held opponents to only seven runs in the last 21.0 innings as a River Cats hurler. Mortensen has the best ERA for any Sacramento starter at 4.42 and has done that in the most innings (130.1) over 22 starts. He will face Fresno tonight opposite right-hander Kevin Pucetas, who holds an impressive 10-4 record and a 4.19 ERA. Mortensen was acquired by Oakland, along with third baseman Brett Wallace, in a July 2009 trade that sent outfielder Matt Holliday to the St. Louis Cardinals.

Power up: With home runs from Matt Carson and Travis Buck on Friday night, Sacramento has already hit 37 homers through 27 games in August, with three games remaining in the month. This is a season high for home runs in a month. Sacramento had 31 in July, 30 in June, and 18 in both April and May. It seems as if the Cats are getting better at crushing the long ball as the season rolls on. Last year's River Cats hit 177 home runs; this year's team currently boasts 134 homers. Tacoma currently leads the PCL with 159 homers. Matt Carson, who has hit seven homers in his last nine games played, leads all River Cats with 23 homers, and Eric Munson and Brett Wallace each have 13 homers this season.

Road warriors: The River Cats continued their road dominance with an eight-game trek to Nashville and Memphis from August 14-21. After dropping the first game in Memphis, Sacramento won the next three games against the Redbirds and then went on to sweep the Sounds. Sacramento finished the season 14-2 against the Pacific Coast League's American North Division, with all those games being played on the road. The River Cats have lost only one road series all season (May 8-11 in Las Vegas). In their last 12 road series, the Cats have seven series victories, five splits and no losses. Overall, Sacramento is 39-24 on the road.

The American way: Sacramento has dominated its American Conference competition this season, holding a 26-6 record against the opposite conference. Sacramento is 3-1 against the Albuquerque Isotopes, who will likely advance to the playoffs in the American South Division. The River Cats are 4-0 against Nashville, 3-1 against Memphis and 3-1 against Iowa – those three teams are competing for the American North title.

TONIGHT'S STARTING PITCHER

RHP Clayton Mortensen (8-8, 4.42)

In his last start with Sacramento (August 24) Mortensen got his eighth loss to Portland who managed eight hits and six earned runs in 4.1 innings. On August 19 at Nashville, Mortensen allowed only one run in 7.0 innings to earn the victory. He struck out seven and walked two in perhaps his most impressive outing in four starts as a River Cat ... On August 14 against Memphis at Raley Field, Mortensen allowed four earned runs in 3.0 innings to take the loss. He allowed nine hits and threw 84 pitches, 51 strikes ... On August 2 against Portland, Mortensen received a no-decision for his 5.1 innings of work, where he allowed only five hits and one run to score. Mortensen, who was acquired by the Oakland A's organization from St. Louis in a trade July 25, allowed one run over 5.2 innings in his first start for Sacramento this season, on July 27 at Colorado Springs. Mortensen, 24, is a tall and slender (6-4, 180) right-hander who has registered a 7-6 mark with a 4.37 ERA in 105.0 innings of work at Memphis this season. Another first-round pick (36th overall) by the Cardinals (Gonzaga), the Rexburg, Idaho product also has made one major league appearance this year. He allowed five hits and six runs (two earned) in three innings of relief work against San Francisco June 29 at St. Louis. Last season, Mortensen combined for an 8-10 mark and 4.91 ERA in 139.2 innings and 26 games (25 starts) in the minors with Memphis (5-6, 5.51 ERA in 15 games) and Springfield (3-4, 4.22 in 11 appearances).

vs. Fresno (0-0, 5.40): Mortensen has faced Fresno only once in his two years on the Triple-A mound. On that occasion (August 1, 2008), he threw for 5.0 innings and allowed seven hits and three earned runs. He will take the mound tonight in game four against Fresno's Kevin Pucetas, who boasts a 10-4 record.
