NOTES: Garcia threw 5.1 shutout innings in Memphis' Game 1 victory over Albuquerque ... allowed nine runs over 21.0 regular season innings with Memphis ... had a 2-0 record.

3-peat watch: The River Cats are attempting to become the first team to win three consecutive Pacific Coast League titles since Albuquerque did it from 1980-82. Sacramento has won two Triple-A titles (2007, 2008), four PCL titles (2003, 2004, 2007, 2008) and eight division titles (2000, 2001, 2003, 2004, 2005, 2007, 2008, 2009) in its 10-year history.

Slugging to history: Sacramento slugger Chris Carter already has four home runs in these playoffs – one in each game of the Tacoma series – and one more Carter bomb will set a River Cats record for most home runs in a single postseason. The first baseman/outfielder is currently tied with Daric Barton, Donnie Murphy, Brooks Conrad and Chris Denorfia.

Cats and 'Birds: Sacramento has never faced Memphis in the postseason, but holds a 30-18 all-time regular season record over the Redbirds. The River Cats went 3-1 against Memphis this season (August 14-17), with all four games being played in Memphis' AutoZone Park.

Brett 'The Hit Man' returns: The Championship Series marks the postseason return of River Cats slugger Brett Wallace to Memphis. Wallace was traded from Memphis (the St. Louis Cardinals' Triple-A affiliate) to Sacramento (the Oakland A's Triple-A affiliate) on July 25 in a deal that sent All-Star slugger Matt Holliday from Oakland to St. Louis. Wallace hit .467 with two homers in his regular season return to Memphis during a four-game road trip in August.

The American way: Sacramento dominated its American Conference competition this season, holding a 26-6 record against the opposite conference. Sacramento went 3-1 against the Memphis Redbirds during a mid-August road trip that concluded with a four-game sweep of the Nashville Sounds. Sacramento also went 3-1 against the Albuquerque Isotopes, who won the Pacific Coast League American South Division.

Conference Championship series: The Memphis Redbirds swept the Albuquerque Isotopes in the PCL American Conference Championship Series. Redbirds pitchers allowed only four runs over the three games ... Sacramento topped the Tacoma Rainiers in four games, scoring 36 runs and hitting eight home runs in the four games.

Elite company: Now having won eight South Division titles in 10 seasons, the Sacramento River Cats have put themselves in elite company among other professional teams. This decade, among the four major sports and Triple-A baseball, only two other teams (the New York Yankees and Detroit Red Wings) have won eight division titles. Sacramento finished the season 86-57, its third-best record in franchise history.

Season series notes: Memphis won the opening game of the team's four-game series in Memphis from August 14-17, but Sacramento came back to win the final three ... Adrian Cardenas and Brett Wallace both went 7-for-15 (.467) over the four-game series ... Shawn Chacon allowed one run over 7.2 innings to record a victory.

Regular season notes: Sacramento dominated one-run games, going 25-13, including 19-3 at home ... The River Cats fared slightly better against right-handed starters, going 62-39 (.614) against righties and 24-18 (.571) against lefties ... The River Cats lost only three road series all season, however two of those were on the team's final road trip ... The River Cats are 32-11 on weekends.

TONIGHT'S GAME 1 STARTING PITCHER

RHP Chris Gissell (0-0, 3.52 regular season)

2009 POSTSEASON

Gissell secured a Game 1 victory in Tacoma by allowing only two runs over 5.0 innings. He struck out six batters and walked only one, allowing seven hits in the performance ... the right-hander threw 91 pitches, 58 strikes, as Sacramento rolled onto an 8-2 victory on route to a 3-games-to-1 series victory.

2009 REGULAR SEASON/CAREER

In his second start with Sacramento (Sept. 4 against host Salt Lake), Gissell allowed two runs over 4.2 innings. He threw 76 pitches after throwing only 44 in his first starter. ... In his first start with Sacramento this season (August 30 vs. Fresno), Gissell allowed two runs (one earned) over 3.0 innings ... Gissell was signed as a free agent this season after playing baseball in Taiwan ... Gissell was called up to Sacramento from extended spring training May 15, 2008. With Sacramento last season, he compiled a 7-3 record and 3.43 ERA. He started 12 games, and came in relief 13 times, recording one save ... Gissell was signed as a free agent by Sacramento on August 30 after spending most of 2009 pitching in Taiwan. ... The 31 year-old was selected by Cubs in fourth round of the 1996 draft; signed June 6, 1996.

vs. Memphis (4-1, 4.25): Gissell has faced Memphis 10 times in his Triple-A career, including five starts and five relief appearances. His most recent start was a 2008 victory on Aug. 4 when he allowed two runs and six hits over 5.0 innings. His other nine appearances came in 2004 or earlier. Gissell has pitched in the Pacific Coast League in 2008, 2005, 2004, 2003 and 2002.
