Fast start: Eric Patterson showed off his speed once again Sunday afternoon, igniting the River Cats' sixth-inning rally with a triple down the right-field line. The left-handed speedster came around to score on Cliff Pennington's double, the first of three runs Sacramento scored in the go-ahead rally during a 3-2 victory. Patterson is tied for fourth in the Pacific Coast League with five triples, and leads the team in that category. On Saturday night, Patterson opened the bottom of the first inning with a hit by pitch. After Gregorio Petit struck out, Patterson stole second and third base during Travis Buck's at-bat. Patterson then scored from third on a passed ball, making his 360-foot trek around the bases without a hit. Patterson is second in the PCL with 25 steals, tied with Alcides Escobar (Nashville) and trailing Eric Young Jr. (Colorado Springs, 38 steals). Patterson has also stolen home twice this season; the second time was as part of a successful triple steal for the River Cats. Teammate Cliff Pennington has 21 steals on the year, tied for fourth in the PCL. Only 63 games into the season, Patterson is well on pace to break Bo Porter's single-season River Cats record of 39 stolen bases. The utility player currently leads all active River Cats with a .299 batting average, 44 runs and 72 hits. He is batting .326 in his last 10 games.

Close calls: The River Cats won 3-2 Sunday afternoon, making them 30-15 in games decided by three runs or less. Sacramento is also 13-5 in one-run games, but only 1-3 in one-run games on the road. The team has also already played in 12 extra-inning games this season, and holds a 9-3 record. Much of the reason for Sacramento's success in these close games is credited to the team's bullpen, which carries a 3.80 ERA.

Valley clash: The River Cats have yet to face the Fresno Grizzlies this season, which could make for a heated second-half title race. The teams will play each other 16 times over the next three months, with each team hosting eight games. Sacramento currently holds a 4.0-game lead over Fresno. The teams first meet Monday through Wednesday in Fresno, and the first series at Raley Field is July 1-3.

Welcome home, Jerome: Jerome Williams, tonight's starting pitcher for the River Cats, was originally selected by the San Francisco Giants in the 1999 draft. The right-hander pitched for Fresno, the Giants' Triple-A affiliate, during the 2002, 2003 and 2005, compiling an 11-17 record. This will be Williams' third time facing Fresno – he earned a win as a starter for Iowa in 2006, and pitched 3.1 innings of relief against the Grizzlies while with Las Vegas in 2008. In his first full season with the Giants (2004), Williams posted a 10-7 record and 4.24 ERA. He also pitched with the Giants in 2003 and 2005, and has since pitched for the Chicago Cubs (2005, 2006) and Washington Nationals (2007) in the major leagues. He has a lifetime major league record of 23-29. Williams, who has spent most of his as a starting pitcher, has only appeared out of the bullpen so far this season.

D-lightful performance: The River Cats have committed a Pacific Coast League-low 40 errors on the season and have a PCL-best .983 fielding percentage. Those numbers are also better than any Triple-A team in the International League. Last night, a stellar defensive play by Gregio Petit helped Sacramento preserve its 3-2 victory. In the bottom of the ninth inning, Tacoma had the tying runner at first with no outs. Bryan LaHair smoked a ground that looked destined for center field, but Petit ranged far to his right and dove to stop the grounder. He flipped from his stomach to second baseman Cliff Pennington, who completed the double play.

Lefty has it right: Gio Gonzalez continued his dominant pitching for the River cats on Saturday night, throwing 6.0 shutout innings to earn a victory over Tacoma. The left-hander has now allowed only one run over his last 26.1 innings of work, spanning more than four outings. Gonzalez is also starting to creep onto the Pacific Coast League leaderboard, ranking sixth in ERA (2.75) and fifth in strikeouts (61). He has struck out a combined 17 batters in his last two outings.

TONIGHT'S STARTING PITCHER

RHP Jerome Williams (0-0, 7.07)

Williams, a starter for most of his minor- and major-league career, has pitched exclusively from the bullpen for Sacramento this season ... this will be his first start ... in nine relief appearances, Williams has pitched 14.0 innings and allowed 11 earned runs ... his longest relief appearance was 2.1 innings on June 4 against Salt Lake City, when he allowed four runs ... made his major league debut with the Giants in 2003 ... Has a 23-29 career major league record, including three season (17-14 record) with the San Francisco Giants ... had a 10-win season with the Giants in 2004 ... signed with Oakland as a free agent to a minor league contract on Dec. 1, 2008.

vs. Fresno (1-0, 2.16): Williams has two career appearances against the Fresno Grizzlies, whom he played for in 2002, 2003 and 2005. In 2006, he earned a victory against Fresno while pitching for the Iowa Cubs. He allowed just one run and five hits over 5.0 innings. In 2008 he pitched against Fresno in relief and allowed one run in 3.1 innings.
