Finally, Clay-mation: River Cats fans have waited long enough to see Clayton Mortensen, who is scheduled to make his Raley Field debut tonight. Since being traded to the Oakland organization from St. Louis, Mortensen has made four appearances for Sacramento – all on the road. His most recent outing was a victory in Nashville, during which he allowed only one run over 7.0 innings. Mortensen was scheduled to make a home start at Raley Field earlier in the season, but he was called up to the Oakland A's on the day of his scheduled start. Mortensen (8-7, 4.14 overall; 1-1, 3.00 with Sacramento) was traded to Oakland along with Brett Wallace in a deal that sent Matt Holliday to the Cardinals.

No sweep for you: The River Cats have not been swept in a series since July 7-9, 2006, when they dropped three games in Salt Lake. That's 116 consecutive series played without getting swept. The River Cats have not been swept in a four-game series since June 3-6, 2006, when they dropped four home games against Las Vegas. After losing the first two games to Portland over the weekend, Sacramento needs to win one of the final two games to keep the streak alive. Sacramento has not been swept in 32 series so far this season, and had not been swept in 36 series in each of the previous two series. In 2006, they were not swept in the final two series of the season. In a May series against Las Vegas earlier this season, Sacramento lost the first three games while getting outscored 31-18. They recovered, however, to win the final game of that series 12-7 and keep the streak alive.

Road warriors: The River Cats continued their road dominance with an eight-game trek to Nashville and Memphis from August 14-21. After dropping the first game in Memphis, Sacramento won the next three games against the Redbirds and then went on to sweep the Sounds. After winning seven of eight games on the trip, Sacramento finished the season 14-2 against the Pacific Coast League's American North Division, with all those games being played on the road. The River Cats have lost only one road series all season (May 8-11 in Las Vegas). In their last 12 road series, the Cats have seven series victories, five splits and no losses. Overall, Sacramento is 39-24 on the road.

Case of the Mondays? Sure!: The River Cats are 5-2 in Monday home games this season, and 10-7 overall. The only day in which the River Cats have a losing record are Thursdays, when they are 9-10. The River Cats are extremely hot on the weekend days, when they are a combined 30-9. They were 30-7 on Saturdays and Sundays before dropping the first two games of their current series to the Portland Beavers.

The American way: Sacramento has dominated its American Conference competition this season, holding a 26-6 record against the opposite conference. Sacramento is 3-1 against the Albuquerque Isotopes, who will likely advance to the playoffs in the American South Division. The River Cats are 4-0 against Nashville, 3-1 against Memphis and 3-1 against Iowa – those three teams are competing for the American North title.

Coast-ing along: The River Cats have held at least a share of the PCL Pacific South Division lead since April 17, when they lost to Tacoma and slipped to second for the day. The River cats' magic number is currently three, with 15 games remaining in the season. Sacramento currently has its largest division lead of the season, leading the second-place Fresno Grizzlies (68-60) and Reno Aces (68-60) by 12.5 games. Sacramento (80-48) is one game behind the franchise record for most wins through 126 games. The 2003 team was 81-47 at this point in the season.

Power up: The River Cats smacked 18 home runs during their eight-game road trip to Memphis and Nashville. Leading the charge was Brett Wallace, who has five homers over his last eight games, and Anthony Recker, who has three in his last six. Sacramento has already hit 30 homers through 22 games in August. Their high total for home runs in a month this season is 31 in July. They also had 30 in June. The River Cats totalled only 36 home runs in April and May combined. Last year's River Cats hit 177 home runs. Tacoma currently leads the PCL with 152 homers. Matt Carson leads all River Cats with 19 homers, smacking his most recent Sunday afternoon. Eric Munson and Brett Wallace each have 13 homers this season, although six of Wallace's came before he was traded to the Oakland organization.

TONIGHT'S STARTING PITCHER

RHP Clayton Mortensen (8-7, 4.14)

In his last start with Sacramento (August 19 at Nashville), Mortensen allowed only one run in 7.0 innings to earn the victory. He struck out seven and walked two in perhaps his most impressive outing in four starts as a River Cat ... On August 14 against Memphis at Raley Field, Mortensen allowed four earned runs in 3.0 innings to take the loss. He allowed nine hits and threw 84 pitches, 51 strikes ... On August 2 against Portland, Mortensen received a no-decision for his 5.1 innings of work, where he allowed only five hits and one run to score. Mortensen, who was acquired by the Oakland A's organization from St. Louis in a trade July 25, allowed one run over 5.2 innings in his first start for Sacramento this season, on July 27 at Colorado Springs. Mortensen, 24, is a tall and slender (6-4, 180) right-hander who has registered a 7-6 mark with a 4.37 ERA in 105.0 innings of work at Memphis this season. Another first-round pick (36th overall) by the Cardinals (Gonzaga), the Rexburg, Idaho product also has made one major league appearance this year. He allowed five hits and six runs (two earned) in three innings of relief work against San Francisco June 29 at St. Louis. Last season, Mortensen combined for an 8-10 mark and 4.91 ERA in 139.2 innings and 26 games (25 starts) in the minors with Memphis (5-6, 5.51 ERA in 15 games) and Springfield (3-4, 4.22 in 11 appearances).

vs. Portland (1-1, 3.63): Mortensen has faced Portland three times in his career, including twice this season. He started against the Beavers with Sacramento on August 2, getting a no-decision after allowing only one run in 5.1 innings. He also started against Portland once with Memphis this season, earning a win after allowing one run in 6.0 innings. He has combined for nine strikeouts and five walks in his two starts against the Beavers this season. In 2008 with Memphis, Mortensen lost his only start against Portland, allowing five runs in 6.0 innings.
